

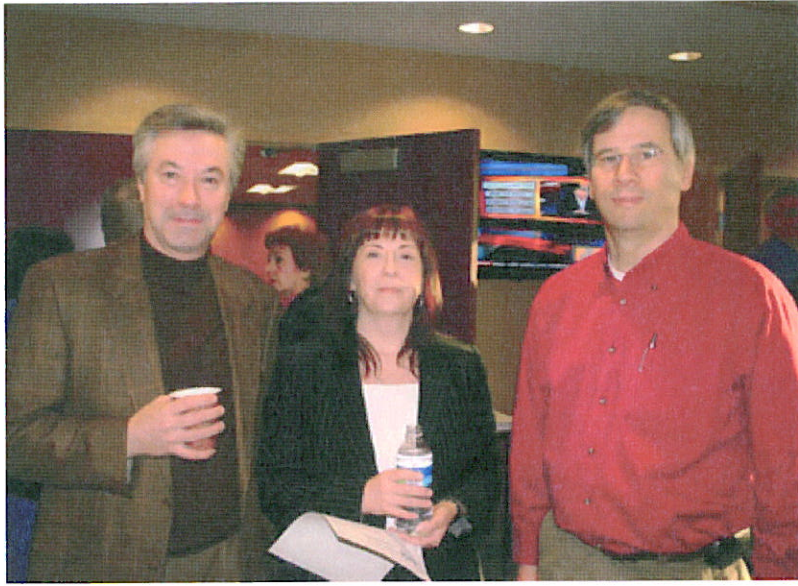

## Cloud Computing; Phone Automation; Kipps

**This morning** we were at **Agilex's** Chantilly offices for the **NVTC Cool Tech** Committee Meeting where **Kevin Jackson**, biz dev superstar at **Dataline**, told us that **cloud computing** is cutting into money spent on **service-oriented architecture** and is expected to be a **\$160 billion** industry by **2011**.



Kevin, a cloud computing guru, tells us he's working with **The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center** in San Diego to help develop "**tactical clouds**" that let military personnel abroad, like a ship commander running a **nuclear simulation**, tap into **extra-computing power**. "There's not enough space to hold the computing power to run that type of program; but if there were a **cloud computing network tied to a super computer**, he could use that," Kevin says.
